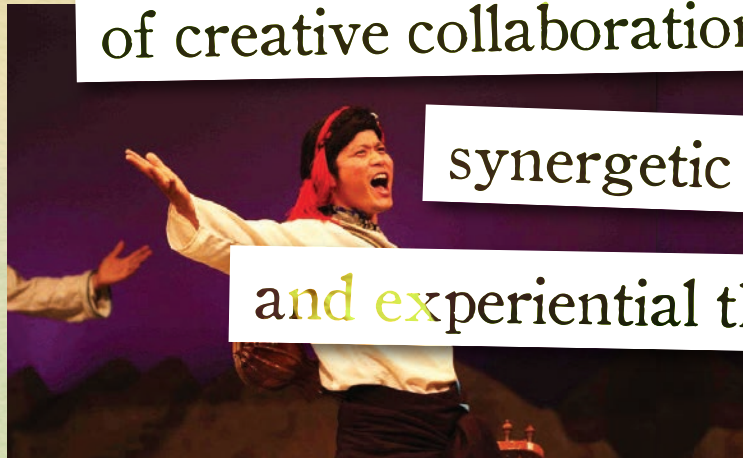

Mission

Operations

TigerLion Arts has accomplished an extraordinary number of complex and dynamic productions by leveraging a **lean, efficient, and highly effective** operating team:

- 2 paid staff members who serve together as Executive and Producing Artistic leaders
- 1 part-time administrative assistant
- **Multiple** contractors, bringing marketing, development, production, and design expertise
- 5 working members of the Board of Directors

The pivotal ingredient to TigerLion Arts' decade-long success has been our involvement with strong, like-minded partners who have brought their creative and administrative talents to each of our endeavors.

Culture

Our work is grounded in **open-heartedness, collaboration** and the highest level of **artistic excellence**. TigerLion Arts intends to serve people of all ages, origins, perspectives, and abilities, and **inspire** them to take positive action in their lives and in the world.

10+ Years of TigerLion Arts

2007

We grow amidst our peers as emerging artists in the Minneapolis arts community. We ask family and friends to contribute to the founding of TLA as a **501c3 non-profit**. This seed funding fuels the creation of multiple far-reaching **original productions and programs**, touching the lives of **diverse audiences nationwide**, including:

The Brush Master – a theatrical tribute to the life and death of Zen master **Kobun Chino Roshi**, created with shadow artist Masanari Kawahara and calligrapher Marlow Brooks.



2010

Nature – the outdoor telling of **Emerson and Thoreau's** mutual love of the natural world, created with Emerson descendent Tyson Forbes, premieres at the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum. It has since toured to over **20 locations** throughout the nation, and been seen by over **25,000** audience members.



2011

KIPO! – a circus of spirit, song, and dance, celebrating Tibet's unique culture and artistry. TLA hosts 20 members from the **Tibetan Institute of Performing Arts** (Dharamsala, India) to co-create this **official arts component** of the Dalai Lama's 2011 Minnesota visit.

Buddha Prince Backstage – a **Twin Cities PBS** documentary featuring the inspired creation process with the Minnesota Tibetan community, and the unique 'walking play' style for which TLA is renowned. The program airs in perpetuity to any Minnesotan with a television.



2008 - 2009

The Buddha Prince – a walking play through the life of the **14th Dalai Lama**. Endorsed with high acclaim by the **Office of Tibet**, it performs in Minneapolis, Los Angeles, and New York City's **Central Park**. The ensemble always consists of a richly diverse cast, and draws from the talents of Minnesota's Tibetan community.



2012

The Dragons Are Singing Tonight – the "musical tale of a nasty dragon" is an adaptation of children's poet laureate **Jack Prelutsky's** book of dragon poems, created with composer Laurie MacGregor, **Circus Juventas**, and the **Minnesota Boychoir**. The sold-out children's musical performs its flying dragon finale at the 2012 Ivey Awards.

Dragon's School Residency Program – TLA is awarded a **\$50K Minnesota State Arts Board (MSAB)** grant to offer a semester of music and puppetry workshops to over 1000 public school children, culminating in a large-scale concert and parade.

2013

The Flame Brigade – TLA is funded by John S. and James L. **Knight Foundation** to create this 10-minute clown show for the **Minnesota State Fair**.

The Cosmic Equation – a creative collaboration with artist/writer Steve Brooks to bring his graphic novel to the stage at the **Minnesota Fringe Festival**.



2017

Nature – with funding from the **National Endowment for the Arts** and **National Park Service** (\$15K), **Nature** performs for the first time in **Concord, MA** at the historic **Old Manse**, bringing national attention to the production. The two-week run is **sold out** with media exposure on NPR, WGBH, and other local news outlets.

TLA offers **Nature** for **free** to the public and Twin Cities schools in the urban Fair Oaks Park in Minneapolis with funding from **MRAC** (\$10K). Over 750 students attend.



2014

Nature – TLA develops the script, score, design and choreography for a five-week ticketed remount at the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum. We also integrate local, volunteer **Community Chorus** members into the production, an opportunity we continue to offer on tour that deeply connects us to each community we visit.

2015 - 2016

Nature – TLA launches a national tour called **Nature for the Nation**, with funding from the **MSAB Arts Touring** (\$90K), **Metropolitan Regional Arts Council** (MRAC, \$10K) and **South Eastern Minnesota Arts Council** (\$10K). Sets and systems are redesigned and built for touring, and new **girl actors** are cast at every location. **17 new communities** in Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois and Ohio pay to host **Nature**.

For outreach on tour, TLA develops and offers the **I Went For a Walk Today** arts-in-nature workshop and accompanying curriculum in **The Field Journal**, along with curated Q&As. The workshops are also offered at national conferences for the **Land Trust Alliance** and **Perpich Center for Arts Education**.



2018

Nature: Walking with Emerson & Thoreau – TLA teams up with Twin Cities PBS and **Emergence Pictures** to create this **Regional Emmy® Award**-winning documentary about **Nature** and the importance of Emerson and Thoreau in today's world. The film airs in perpetuity, fulfilling our goal to reach broader audiences.



Big World – the title of our new project! A global variety show offering video, book and music products. Ongoing development workshops have generated a great deal of material (themes, characters, design, etc.). We look forward to offering preliminary showings of the work in 2019!

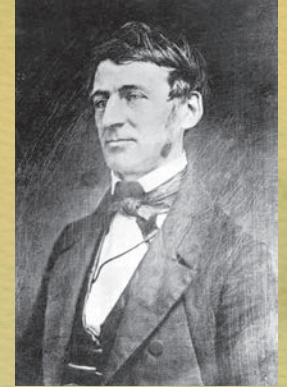

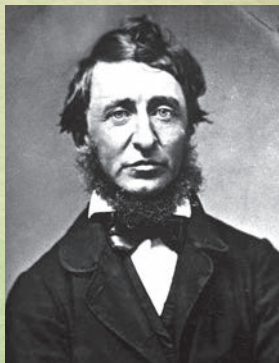
